SCHOOL

Atomi High School is a private girls' school comprising a threeyear middle school and a threeyear comprehensive senior high school. Approximately 1,600 students are currently enrolled in grades seven through twelve. The school opened in 1875 as the first girls' school in Tokyo. Over the past 139 years, the school has graduated more than twentythousand students.

COMMUNITY

Located in downtown Tokyo, Atomi High School is an easy commute. The school can be reached by a ten-minute subway ride from Tokyo Station. Students come from adjacent prefectures of Saitama, Chiba, Kanagawa and Ibaraki as well as from Tokyo. With numerous prestigious educational institutions at all school levels nearby, the area is known as one of Japan's most leading educational districts.

CURRICULUM

The academic year (AY) starts in April and ends in March. The academic program is organized on a traditional schedule. All students up to grade eleven take 34 classes per week with each class 50 minutes in length. Seniors choose to take 30 to 34 classes according to their needs. Classes are streamed for most courses in English and math and some in Japanese.

The school does not offer any advanced placement courses or honor classes.



GRADING AND RANKING Rank

Students are notified of their ranking in mid-term and final examinations, and overall term grades.

Grade Point Average (GPA) Calculation

GPA is computed using the quality points below. All subjects taken are included in the

computation. Seventy-eight credits are required for graduation from the senior high school. Interim grades are recorded on the transcript and GPA is computed in July for all students before they receive their final grades in March. Seniors receive second interim grades in October, when GPA is recalculated.


National Center Test for University Admissions Results
